ACCESS TO OPPORTUNITY



ECHO PARK REHABILITATION

This project revitalized a community gem that captures and cleans 100 million gallons of water each year, as well as providing recreational space for families. The rehabilitation of Echo Park Lake also created over 50 union construction jobs and exceeded the goals for local hire, targeted hire of disadvantaged workers, and number of apprenticeships.
